Keith Taber is Vice President of Fleet Operations, a position he assumed in June 2017.

Prior to joining Southern Nuclear, Keith served as Site Vice President at Exelon Corp.'s Clinton Power Station in Clinton, Ill. He began his career at Exelon in 1991 as a System Engineer at LaSalle County Station in Marseilles, Ill. He progressed through various positions before being promoted to Operations Shift Manager in 2002. He was named Outage Manager in 2005. Two years later, he became Work Control Director, then Operations Director in 2010. In 2011, he was named Plant Manager at Clinton Power Station, and was promoted to Site Vice President in 2013. Keith joined Southern Nuclear as the Site Vice President of Vogtle 1&2 in October, 2014.

Keith has a bachelor's degree in nuclear engineering from the University of Missouri at Rolla. He also held a Senior Reactor Operator License at LaSalle County Generating Station.
