David P. Poroch is executive vice president and chief financial officer of Southern Company, one of America's largest public utilities serving nine million customers through its subsidiaries.

Prior to his current role, Poroch served as senior vice president, comptroller and chief accounting officer of Southern Company where he was responsible for accounting policy, research, financial reporting, and income taxes as well as several support functions such as payroll and accounts payable.

In previous roles, Poroch served as executive vice president and chief financial officer (CFO) of Southern Company Gas as well as executive vice president, CFO and treasurer of Georgia Power where he oversaw the accounting and finance functions, including financial reporting and planning, regulatory accounting, analysis, and enterprise risk management. In addition, at Georgia Power, he was responsible for the company's innovative results delivery office. Prior to serving as CFO at two of Southern Company's regulated subsidiaries, Poroch served as vice president and comptroller of Georgia Power from 2014 to 2019. Poroch began his career with the Southern Company enterprise in 2012 as vice president and chief audit executive for Southern Company Services.

Previously, Poroch was a partner with Deloitte & Touche LLP, where he gained nearly two decades of experience in the utility sector.

Poroch earned his bachelor's degree in business administration from Northwood University in Midland, Michigan. A certified public accountant, he is licensed in Georgia, Michigan and Florida. David also serves on the boards of the Atlanta Botanical Gardens, Georgia Council on Economic Education and the Humane Society of Northeast Georgia.
