

Auction Compliance Disclosures

The following information is being posted voluntarily by Southern Companies in conjunction with the Energy Auction and in an effort to keep participants informed about the implementation and operation of the Energy Auction. Participants should continue to direct requests for more information, as well as questions, comments or complaints, to the Auction Administrator or the Independent Auction Monitor utilizing the links provided on the previous page.

- On September 27, 2021 and October 12, 2021, Southern was notified by the Auction Monitor of a potential failed offer submission (despite the availability of capacity), for September 26 HE 5 and October 11 HE 21 respectively. Southern researched the issue and determined that the submissions were made for the referenced hours; however, the offers did not post to the Auction platform due to system issues on the platform. Southern is working with the platform administrator on appropriate measures to avoid such an event in the future. 10/14/2021
- On September 16, 2021, Southern confirmed that a supply curve for the September 15 Hour-Ahead Auction for HE 3 failed to upload. Southern determined that system connectivity failed to function as intended, and upon refreshing systems, connectivity returned to normal functionality. Southern is researching the root cause for this occurrence. No bids were submitted for HE 3; accordingly, no auctions were impacted as a result of the incident. 9/20/2021
